Recreation Policy

Statement of purpose: To achieve its stated purpose “to promote and advocate for the general welfare of persons with autism,” the Chippewa Valley Autism Society may occasionally donate funds to meet the recreational needs of persons on the autism spectrum. (This policy assumes that their medical, therapeutic and educational needs are better met through other venues – schools, hospitals, and state/county funds like the autism waiver program.)

Eligibility: Any family with a member diagnosed with any of the pervasive developmental disorders may be granted recreational funds upon approval by a majority of the CVAS board. However, any single family will receive recreational funds from CVAS a maximum of one time per year. Only CVAS members are eligible. For non-member families, the cost of membership will be subtracted from the amount of the recreational award.
